These classes will run based upon student enrollment in each course. Students who fail a subject, or who are unable to continue in a sequential subject, are urged to attend summer school to fulfill requirements.

There will be a tuition charge of \$200.00 per course for students who reside in the communities of Bridgewater or Raynham and \$225.00 for students who reside in communities other than Bridgewater and Raynham. Tuition refunds will be made only if the course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.

All payments must be paid with a cash, money order payable to B.R.R.S.D. or you may go online www.bridge-rayn.org to the online payment tab and pay by credit card, Tuition is due in full at the time of registration.

No subject failed may be made up in summer school where the student has been absent from that subject more than 15 days during the regular academic year or if the grade average for the subject was below 45. Exceptions to this may be appealed to the Principal for review, consideration, and final disposition. Students needing help in subject areas not offered will be allowed, with administrative permission, to take courses at other recognized summer schools, as long as the criteria in the paragraph above have been met.

All students must attain a 90% summer school attendance record to receive academic credit. The briefness of the summer school program demands this level of attendance. This summer students are not allowed more than 2 absences. In addition, the passing grade for a summer school course will be 70 for BRRHS students.

**Credit Retrieval** will be offered to those students who have passed their courses but have had too many absences to receive credit. These courses will be offered in the evenings either from 5:00 P.M. - 6:30 P.M. or 6:30 P.M. - 7:50 P.M. Monday—Thursday (June 24 -July 24). Registration must be done during registration for summer school. Orientation is 6/24 @ 4:15. p.m.

It is suggested that the student check the Parent and Student Handbook for graduation credit requirements and minimum credit requirements on a yearly basis. If the total graduation credits, or credits needed to maintain level, cannot be achieved during the regular school year, summer school should receive serious consideration in your planning.
