Tuition: Tuition is \$225 per course and must be in the form or cash or money order made payable to Stoughton Summer School. There will be no refunds once classes have started.

Dates of Attendance: Stoughton Summer School will begin on Monday, July 6th and conclude Friday, July 31st. Classes are held Monday through Thursday 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM and Fridays virtually. Depending on what class a student signs up for he/she will be in class on Mondays and/or Wednesdays or on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays. All classes held Monday – Thursday are located at StoughtonHigh School in the cafeteria, all Friday check-ins will be virtual. All students will be required to wear a mask and adhere to social distancing measures put in place while on the Stoughton High School campus.

Credit Eligibility: Students who have failed a full year course and have passed at least one term are eligible for Summer School credit. Students who have failed a one-semester course and have passed at least one term are eligible for summer school credit. A withdrawal from any course during the academic year will disqualify the student from earning credit in summer school. Students who have lost credit due to excessive absences are reminded that they must complete the four-week Summer School program, meet the Stoughton Summer School attendance requirements, and pass the course in order to receive credit. Students will not receive credit if conduct in Summer School is inappropriate. There will be no refund if credit is denied.

Registration & Payment: Registration is open to students in grades 9-12. Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. Students may register by mail by completing the application below and enclosing payment in the form of a money order payable to Stoughton Summer School. Students may enroll in person at Stoughton High School from 9:00 AM to 2:30 PM Monday, June 22- Friday, June 29 or Monday, June 29 - Thursday, July 2. The building will be closed on Friday, July 3. The Summer School Office is located at the bus entrance of Stoughton High School, 232 Pearl St., Stoughton, Ma. A \$25.00 late registration fee is applicable on any registrations after July 2, 2020. Registrations will not be accepted after the first day of class.

Summer School Policy: A student may attend Stoughton Summer School to fulfill graduation requirements or to raise a grade in order to continue in a sequential course. Courses will be offered to all students using the Plato on-line curriculum.

Registration Confirmation: Students will be notified if a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or if a class is full and registrations are no longer being accepted. Confirmations will not be sent. All questions can be directed to Deb Parker at d parker@stoughtonschools.org.
