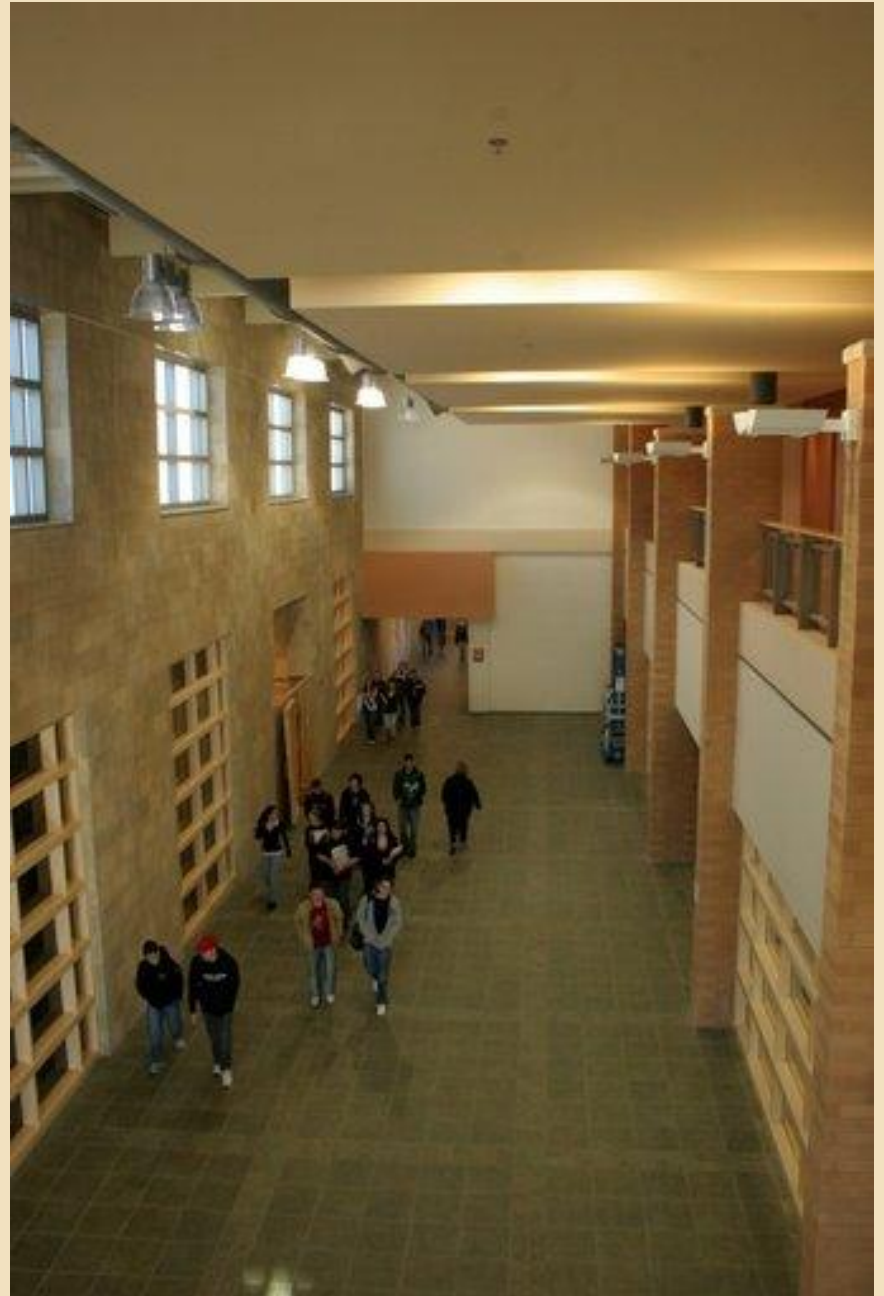

- Naming allows individuals, families, groups or community businesses to provide additional, private support to the School Community while simultaneously leaving an historic imprint on the building.

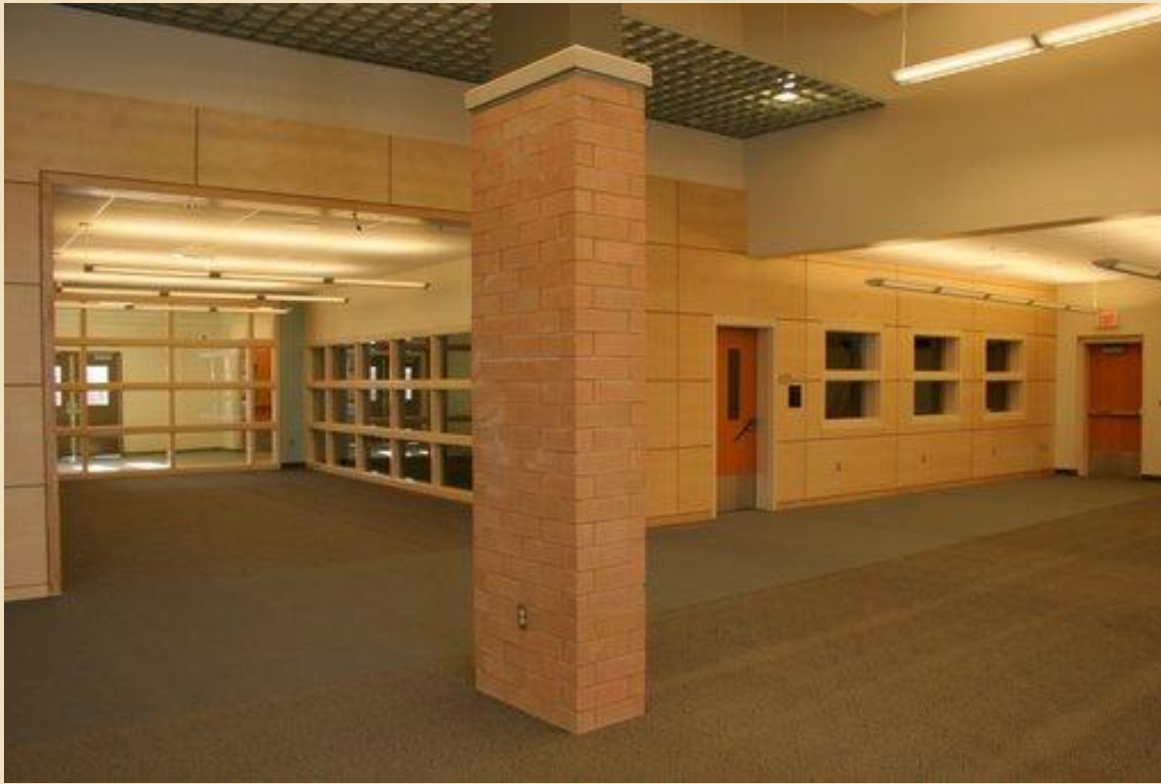

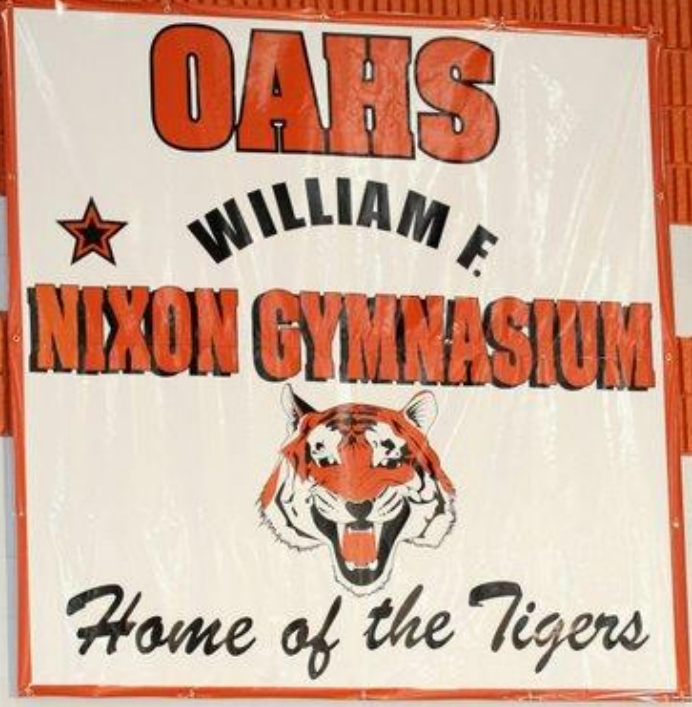
